ESTIMATED COSTS:

50% Travel Airfare: One round trip flight. plus connecting flights to 1 or 2 cities in Europe.

50% Accommodation and Per diem: Budgeted amount is 50% of 400\$ per day.

50% Local Transit Costs: Some costs covered 50% by funding

0% Registration Costs: CGLCC registration fee waived (valued at \$1200), additional local

registrations TBD but expected to be minimal.

Participation may include any of: B2B matchmaking in new markets, inclusion in international promotion/media, inclusion in the Canadian Delegation Directory, access to global affiliate international member networking receptions including possible embassy socials, corporate meet and greets, business development training sessions and workshops.
